Pandemic Training Guidelines

TRAINING GUIDELINES DURING AND AFTER COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1. Safety Classes will be limited to between 5 - 9 employees at the Sioux Falls AGC Training Center and 5 - 8 in Rapid City at the CIC because of room size and the 10 person max guideline. If training will be performed at member locations, the CDC guidelines of the 6' separation rule will be followed so class sizes need to be planned out prior to class start.
2. Prior to the class date, and immediately before beginning class, Supervisors of attendees should communicate with course participants and tell them not to attend training if they have any known medical condition or illness, or show any signs or symptoms consistent with an illness. Instructors will offer students the opportunity to speak discreetly prior to the start of class, should they have any questions or concerns about their health status as it relates to class participation.
3. All instructors and course participants should practice proper hygiene before and after classes, and before and after breaks in the class, including hand washing for at least 20 seconds.
4. Classroom tables and chairs will be cleaned and sanitized after each class.
5. Tables/Desks will be wiped down prior to class and after returning from lunch or breaks.
6. Hands on portions will be done with care. We will maintain social distancing of at least 6' at all times.
 - All training equipment, including CPR manikins and other first aid and resuscitation devices, should be thoroughly cleaned and decontaminated after each use in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations.
 - Hands will be sanitized before and after use of machines.
 - All PPE including masks and gloves will be worn where appropriate.
